ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14

TEMPORARY TRAFFIC RESTRICTIONS – BELVEDERE ROAD

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that, to enable footway and carriageway works, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth intends to make an Order, the effect of which would be to:
 - (a) Phase one:
temporarily prohibit vehicles travelling in a south-easterly direction on the .unnamed access road opposite No. 7 Belvedere Road, from turning right onto Belvedere Road, so to travel in a south-westerly direction
 - (b) Phase two:
temporarily prohibit vehicles from entering or proceeding in those lengths of Belvedere Road between outside the northernmost pedestrian entrance of Jubilee Gardens and outside the southernmost pedestrian entrance of Jubilee Gardens.
2. The alternative routes for affected vehicles would be available via Belvedere Road, Waterloo Road, York Road and Chicheley Street, and vice versa.
3. The Order would come into force on 7 April 2026 and would continue in force for a maximum duration of six month to allow for contingencies, or until the works have been completed whichever is the sooner. In practice, it is anticipated that the works will take a total of four weeks to complete.
