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Introduction

This report presents the results of the 2026 Lambeth DfE Spring School Census and the annual EAL Proficiency in English Survey. The information provides data for the Local Authority's scheme of formula funding, assists in putting Key Stage 2 and GCSE achievement into the context of schools' intakes and provides general background information to Lambeth policy makers. The detailed overview of the pupil population is also used as supporting evidence for a range of external grant funding and other submissions and reports to government departments and other agencies.

Information from the two surveys includes name, gender, unique pupil number (UPN), free school meals eligibility, home borough, ethnic background, additional languages to English spoken at home, proficiency in English, SEN stage, prime area of special educational need, date of admission to school, date of birth, postcode and national curriculum year as taught.

The 2026 Spring School Census recorded details of 33,842 pupils in all schools including LA-maintained, academies and pupil referral units. The main findings are summarised below.

1. Ethnic Background

The largest ethnic group in Lambeth schools is Black African with 7,178 pupils, or **21.2%** of the pupil population. White British are the second largest ethnic group (**16.1%**) followed by White Other (**14.2%**).

Since 2000, the ethnic composition of Lambeth's pupil population has changed significantly. Black African pupils have become the largest ethnic group, consistently accounting for around one in five pupils. White British pupils, who were the largest group in 2000, are now the second largest, followed by White Other pupils. Over the same period, the proportion of Black Caribbean pupils has experienced the most substantial decline.

The percentage of mixed heritage pupils have steadily increased, with "Mixed Other" and "Mixed White/Caribbean" being the largest groups. Over recent years, the "Mixed Other" category has grown from 6.8% in 2019 to 8.5% in 2026. Other ethnic groups, such as "Any Other Group", "Pakistani" and "Asian Other," have also seen increases.

Overall, the total percentage of ethnic minority pupils has slightly decreased from 82.2% in 2019 to 80.2% in 2026.

2. Main Languages Spoken

14,977 pupils in Lambeth schools (**44.3%**) have a first language that is not English (EAL). After *English* (**55.3%**), the main first language is *Spanish* (**7.0%**), followed by *Portuguese* (**5.3%**) and *Somali* (**3.6%**).

Lambeth schools have experienced notable changes in its language demographic over the past two decades. Since 2000, the proportion of pupils speaking only English has generally declined. However, after reaching a low of 48.9% in 2020, this figure has rebounded to 55.3% in 2026. Across the same period, the percentage of pupils speaking English as an additional language has grown from 37.7% in 2000 to 44.3% in 2026, remaining relatively consistent over recent years.

However, within the EAL group, there have been some notable shifts in the language cohorts. Spanish speakers have increased substantially from 2.4% in 2000, growing to 7.0% in 2026 and establishing themselves as the main EAL language group.

After an initial rise, the number of Portuguese speakers has continued to decline in recent years, falling from 6.9% in 2019 to 5.3% in 2026. As the next largest language group, the percentage of Somali speakers has also fallen slightly, from 4.4% to 3.6% over the same period.

Other language groups remain fairly consistent with much smaller shifts, although French speakers have seen a more noticeable fall since their peak in 2020.

The 2026 school census revealed that pupils in Lambeth collectively spoke 150 identifiable languages (including English), highlighting the borough's rich multilingual community.

Of these, 52 languages had more than 20 speakers, 25 languages had more than 100 speakers, 10 languages had more than 500 speakers and 5 languages had over 1000 speakers.

3. Proficiency in English

Pupils with English an additional language are assessed for their proficiency in English according to the assessment scale:

Stage A	- New to English	Stage D	- Competent
Stage B	- Early acquisition	Stage E	- Fluent
Stage C	- Developing competence	Stage N	- Not yet assessed

Studies consistently show that proficiency in English is the single most important factor influencing the educational achievement of EAL learners. Pupils with higher English proficiency, especially those assessed as *competent* or *fluent* often outperform even native English speakers in key assessments

Lambeth routinely collects proficiency in English data from schools for monitoring purposes. In Spring 2026, 76 of 86 mainstream nursery, primary, secondary and special schools submitted proficiency in English data (88%).

From the data collected in Spring 2026, 19.1% (approximately 1 in 5) of the Lambeth pupil population from nursery to year 11 were *Not Fluent* in English. This includes 3.3% who were at Stage A and a complete beginner to English. English proficiency levels varied sharply across different phases of education, showing significant differences in language acquisition and support needs. The data highlights substantial progression in language acquisition as pupils move through the education system.

In the nursery phase (N1 and N2), 35.4% of pupils were EAL learners classified as Not Fluent (A-C), with most assessed at the earliest proficiency stages (A and B).

In the primary phase (Reception to Year 6), as English language acquisition progresses, the proportion of EAL learners assessed as Not Fluent drops to 23.0%. A larger proportion of pupils were assessed at Stage C (Developing Competence), while the percentage reaching Stages D and E (Competent/Fluent) increased to 21.6%.

In the secondary phase (Years 7 to 11), English language proficiency improved markedly, with most EAL learners achieving higher levels of fluency. Just 7.0% of pupils were classified as Not Fluent, with 31.6% being assessed as Stages D or E (Competent/Fluent).

Data since 2017, shows that the percentage of *Not Fluent* EAL learners in Lambeth schools has fallen slightly from 23% to 19% over the period. Those EAL learners who were *Competent/Fluent* in English has remained fairly consistent, suggesting that the fall in *Not Fluent* is more influenced by the recent growth in Lambeth's non-EAL English-only school population.

4. Free School Meals

In Lambeth schools in Spring 2026, 13,340 pupils (**39.4%**) were eligible for a free school meal.

In Lambeth's nursery schools, **40.3%** were eligible for a free school meal.

In primary schools, **35.4%** of pupils were eligible for a free school meal.

Secondary schools showed a slightly higher rate of FSM at **43.2%**.

Special schools stand out with **63.8%** of pupils eligible for FSM. The highest rate was seen in the PRU where **67.9%** of pupils were eligible for FSM.

Trend data collected since 1991, shows that overall, from a high point of 51.6% FSM in 1994, the percentage of pupils eligible for a free school meal had incrementally fallen year on year to 22.3% in 2018, but since then, there has been a notable shift with FSM numbers rising incrementally. This likely reflects a change in government policy in 2018 which established 'transitional protection for free school meals' enabling pupils who became eligible under the benefits-based criteria to continue to receive FSM until the end of their then current phase, even if their household circumstances changed.

5. Special Educational Needs

The Spring 2026 school census shows that 23.0% (approximately 1 in 4) of the Lambeth school population were identified as having a Special Educational Need, either informally by their teacher as requiring SEN Support (15.6%), or formally by the local authority as having an Education, Health and Care Plan (7.4%).

Nursery schools show the highest rates of SEN Support (25.4%) but the lowest rates of EHCP (2.9%).

Primary schools recorded a slightly higher rate of special educational needs (SEN) than secondary schools (22.1% compared with 19.5%), with rates of both SEN Support and Education, Health and Care Plans (EHCPs) both being marginally higher.

Special schools and the PRU presented the highest rates of SEN overall including 100% of special school pupils and 50.9% of PRU pupils having an EHCP.

After an initial fall in SEN rates across Lambeth schools, the trend has reversed since 2019, with a steady increase driven by incremental rises in the numbers of pupils on both SEN Support and with an EHCP. Significantly, the number of pupils with an EHCP in Lambeth is at a historical high.

The most common reason for SEN in Lambeth schools is Speech, Language and Communication Needs (27.8% of SEN pupils), followed by Autistic Spectrum Disorder (21.4%) and Social, Emotional and Mental Health (18.9%).

6. Borough of Residence

The data highlights the proportions of pupils residing within and outside the borough across educational phases. Overall, three-quarters (**74.5%**) of the cohort are borough residents, while one quarter (**23.4%**) reside outside of Lambeth.

Nursery pupils show the strongest borough affiliation, with 87.3% living in Lambeth.

Primary phase sees the majority living in Lambeth (80%). However, secondary phase sees a more notable shift, with two-thirds (67%) living in Lambeth and 33% (1 in 3) living out of borough.

Special school pupils and those attending the PRU are mainly in borough residents (77.8 and 77.7% respectively).

Outside of Lambeth, most other pupils live in the neighbouring boroughs of Croydon (7.9%), Southwark (5.9%), Merton (3.5%) and Wandsworth (3.1%).
