- 2. The Shop Front Licence will only permit the sale of goods and/or services indicated; and the display of live animals, cigarettes, tobacco, alcohol, solvents, fireworks and knives (inc blades) will not be permitted at the Shop Front.
- 3. The Shop Front Licence will only permit trading and/or display of goods and services on the days and times indicated. The amenities must be removed from the public highway at the end of the permitted period.
- 4. The Licensee shall clearly display their copy of the licence at all times and shall present it for inspection when required to do so by an authorised officer of the Council or by a Police Officer.
- 5. The Licensee is responsible at all times for the proper conduct and operation of the licensed activities at the Shop Front; and shall comply with any proper requirements of an Authorised Officer of the Council.
- 6. The Licensee must at all times, ensure that the licensed activities are carried out in a manner that avoids risk to the health and safety of themselves, employees and members of the public. All equipment and lighting appliances used on the shop front must comply with current Health and Safety standards.
- 7. At the end of each trading day, the licensee will ensure that the area outside his/her shop is left in a clean and tidy condition.
- 8. The Licensee shall pay all licence fees in advance.
- 9. Where the licence fee is paid by cheque, the Licence will be null and void should the relevant cheque be dishonoured on presentation.
- 10. The Licence shall be granted for twelve (12) months (1st April to 31st March); or shorter periods, as the Council considers appropriate.
- 11. No display shall exceed a depth of 1.2 metres from the shop frontage over the footpath. A minimum clear width of 1.8 metres must be maintained on Borough Roads and 2 metres on TFL roads, between the front of the display, the front edge of the kerb or any intervening item of the street furniture.
- 12. This Licence is not transferable.
- 13. The licensee shall remove the amenities from the public highway immediately if requested to do so by the Council, its agents, contractors or licensees or by a statutory undertaker. The licensee shall also remove the amenities from the public highway if requested to do so by a Police Officer if unimpeded access to the surface of the public highway is required. The applicant shall not reposition the amenities on the public highway until notified by the Council, the Statutory Undertaker, or the Police, that he/she may do so.
- 14. Should this consent be granted, the licensee shall indemnify the Council from and against any claim in respect of any injury, damage or loss arising directly or indirectly out of the grant of this consent and the use by the public of the amenities.
