

TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1971
EXTENSION OF CONSERVATION AREA NO. 10 (LAMBETH PALACE)

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth in pursuance of their powers under Section 277 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1971 as amended by Section 1 of the Town and Country Amenities Act 1974 have designated an extension to Conservation Area No. 10 (Lambeth Palace)

A list of the properties included in the extension is shown below in the schedule.

The object of the designation of a Conservation Area or of an extension to a Conservation Area already in existence is to preserve or enhance the character or appearance of an area of special architectural or historic interest as distinct from individual buildings, to control development in the area and to stimulate and encourage measures to improve the environment.

The effect of such designation is that, subject to the provisions of Section 277A of the Town and Country Planning Act 1971 and the exemptions contained therein or made by virtue of any statutory provision therein, no building or part of a building which is situated within the Conservation Area shall be demolished without the written consent first obtained of either the local planning authority (the London Borough of Lambeth) or the Secretary of State for the Environment.
