The dates of such designation were 9th August 1974 (Clapham Park Road) and 27th September 1974

(Northbourne Road). The object of such designation is to preserve or enhance the character or appearance of an area of apocial architectural or historic interest as distinct from individual buildings, to control development in the area and to stimulate and encourage measures to improve the environment.

The effect of such designation is that, subject to the provisions of Section 277a of the Town and Country Planning Act 1971 and the exemptions contained therein or made by virtue of any statutory provision therein, no building or part of a building which is situated within the Conservation Area shall he demolished without the consent first obtained of either the local planning authority or the Secretary of State for the Environment.
