The following report is submitted by the Director of Development

1 On 17 September 1974 the Committee decided that the area outlined on the displayed drawing No UD/CON/174 was an area of special architectural or historic interest which should be designated as a Conservation Area.

2 It is a legal requirement that the Council consult the GLC before designating a Conservation Area, and the committee authorised this consultation. The Greater London Council has replied that it welcomes the designation of this conservation area and agrees that the boundaries constitute a satisfactory definition of the area, and that the designation should now be advertised.

RECOMMENDATION

P + D Committee:

That the area shown outlined on drawing UD/CON/174 be designated a Conservation Area, and this designation be advertised, and the Secretary of State be informed accordingly.
