NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Council of London Borough of Lambeth in pursuance of powers under Section 69 of the Planning (Listed Buildings and Conservation Areas) Act 1990 (as amended) has designated the Rush Common & Brixton Hill Conservation Area (No. 49) on the 27th August 1997 within the London Borough of Lambeth.

This new Conservation Area includes Brixton Hill, Dumbarton Court, Waterworks Road, Medora Road, Crabster Road, Renton Close, Holmewood Road, Cothorstone Road, Josephine Avenue, Raleigh Gardens, Helix Gardens, Ostade Road and parts of Jebb Avenue, Brixton Water Lane, Arodene Road, Endymion Road, Elm Park, Holmewood Gardens, Morrish Road, Maplestead Road, Christchurch Road and New Park Road.

The objective of designation is to preserve or enhance the character or appearance of areas of special or historic, as distinct from individual buildings, to control developments in such areas and to stimulate and encourage measures to improve the environment.

**LONDON BOROUGH OF LAMBETH  
ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT  
1984 - SECTION 14  
TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF  
BELVEDERE ROAD**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that, because work involving the operation of a crane are to be carried out by the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth it is to make an Order the effect of which would temporarily prohibit vehicles except those connected with the works from entering that part of Belvedere Road which lies between its junction with Concert Approach and its junction with the access road between The Royal Festival Hall and The Hay Gallery, whenever such prohibition is indicated by traffic signs.

Alternative routes are available for vehicles via Concert Hall Approach, the roundabout adjacent to Waterloo Bridge and the slip road which links that roundabout with Belvedere Road and via the slip road which Upper Ground with that roundabout, the roundabout York Road and Chicheley Street.

The Order would come into force on 13th September 1997 and would continue for a maximum duration of 14 months or until the works have been completed whichever is the earlier. In practice, it is anticipated that the Order would only have effect on Saturday 13th September 1997 and Sunday 14th September 1997 if the works cannot be carried out or completed those days the Order may also have effect on subsequent dates.
