

# Dunraven School

## Secondary Transfer 2020 – National Offer Day Information



The information provided below relates to offers made on National Offer Day (2 March) for Year 7 places as part of the secondary transfer process. This information is provided as a guideline for families and does not take into account any offers that may be made after National Offer Day.

### How many places have been offered?

Dunraven School's Published Admission Number (PAN) for Year 7 is 158. The PAN is the number of places available to children being admitted to the school for the first time. In addition to the PAN, the cohort has 60 places for children who are already in Year 6 at Dunraven School in the Primary phase, bringing the cohort to 218 places. Where there were known places available from the 60 held for Dunraven primary children, these have been offered to external applicants (for this particular cohort that was 4 places). Due to ongoing oversubscription, local anxiety over the reduction in external places available from 218 to 158 and continued financial pressure, the Governors agreed to offer an additional form of entry for Year 7 for September 2020 (up to 30 additional places). This brings the total number of places offered to external applicants for September 2020 to 192.
