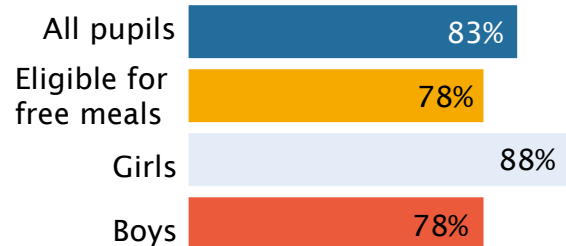

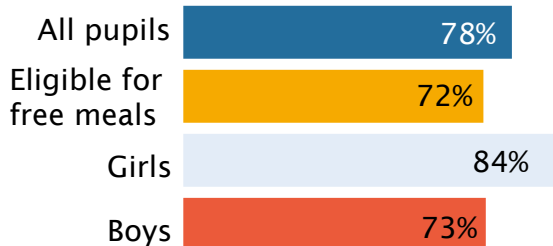
Outcomes for children in Lambeth



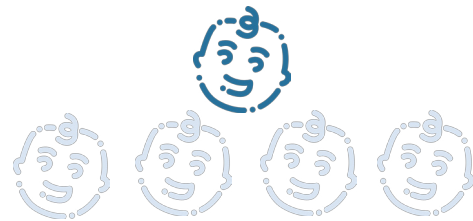
Good level of overall development at age 5



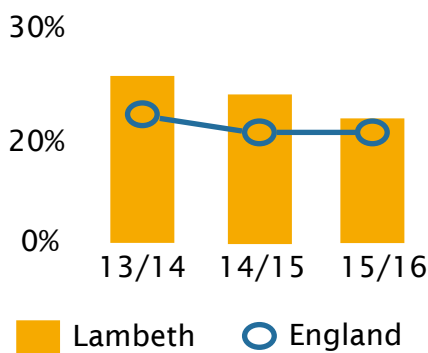
Good level of social and emotional development age 5
