357 sat the test divide by 5 = 71.4 children in each band, this start point was amended to ensure children with the same test score were included in the same band.

The initial band set up was not exactly 71.4 per band, it was best fit to ensure that those with the same test score were placed in the same band.

Some bands ran out of pupils in that band so to ensure that there were no spaces at the end of the process and a waiting list, so the banding capacity was relaxed. This meant that the other bands took in a larger intake to accommodate children using the criteria.

Lambeth School Admissions Team had to prioritise offers to those that sat the test before anyone else could be considered. Those children that did not sit the test were listed in an 'over-flow' band, band Z.

Children listed in band Z were to be considered once all places were offered to those in bands 1 to 5.

On National Offer Day no children from band Z were offered a place as the school was full with children listed in bands 1 to 5, as the bands 1-5 were not fully exhausted ie there were children who were not offered a place at the school of a higher preference.
