4. Baptised Catholic children of parents who are committed practising members of the Catholic faith who live in other Catholic parishes. – **5**
5. Other 'looked after' children and other previously 'looked after' children who have been adopted or have become subject of a residence or guardianship order. – **0**
6. Children of parents who are Catechumens or baptised children who are members of the Eastern Orthodox Churches. Evidence of Baptism or reception from the authorities of that Church will be required. – **2**
7. Children of families who are members of other Christian denominations that are part of the Churches Together in England and who support the aims and practices of the school. Evidence of Baptism (or dedication) provided by a priest or minister of a designated place of worship will be required. – **3**
8. Children of other faiths whose parents support the religious ethos of the school. Evidence of membership of the faith should be provided by a priest, minister or religious leader of a designated place of worship will be required. – **2**
9. Any other children. - **11**
