The initial band set up was not exactly 101 per band, it was best fit to ensure that those with the same test score were placed in the same band.

There was an uneven split in the intake from each band as during the iterative (offer making) due to a discrepancy in the band set up. Those who should have been offered in band 1 were offered on 2/3/18. No offers were withdrawn, but band structure monitored to try and ensure it corrected itself soon after.

Those children that did not sit the test were listed in an 'over-flow' band, band Z.

Children listed in band Z were to be considered once all places were offered to those in bands 1 to 5.

On National Offer Day no children from band Z were offered a place as the school was full with children listed in bursary and bands 1 to 5, as the bands bursary 1-5 were not fully exhausted ie there were children who were not offered a place at the school of a higher preference.
