Generally you will need an up to date CV and access to a computer to start applying for jobs.

CV help

A range of Lambeth organisations provide employment support for Lambeth citizens, which includes CV writing and interview skills.

A CV is usually your first chance to make a good impression and it's worth getting it right. Even if you have to complete an application form for a job you're interested in, it is useful to have a CV to refer to for details of your previous employment.
