1. A referendum will be held on **Thursday 24 October 2019** to decide on the question below:

Do you want the London Boroughs of Lambeth and Southwark to use the Neighbourhood Plan for South Bank and Waterloo to help it decide planning applications in the neighbourhood area?

- 2 Applications, amendments or cancellations of postal votes and amendments or cancellations of existing proxy votes must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at London Borough of Lambeth, Lambeth Town Hall, Brixton Hill, London, SW2 1RW by 5pm on Wednesday 9 October 2019
3. New applications to vote by proxy at this referendum must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at London Borough of Lambeth, Lambeth Town Hall, Brixton Hill, London, SW2 1RW by 5pm on Wednesday 16 October 2019
4. Applications to vote by emergency proxy at this referendum applied for on grounds of physical incapacity, or for work/service reasons must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at London Borough of Lambeth, Town Hall, 2 Brixton Hill, London, SW2 1RW by 5pm on Thursday 24 October 2019. The physical incapacity must have occurred after 5pm on Wednesday 16 October 2019. To apply on the grounds of work/service, the person must have become aware that they cannot go to the polling station in person after 5pm on Wednesday 16 October 2019
