S106 Drawdowns

At the start of 2012/13, the Council's target for the full year was to spend $\pounds 6.6m$ in S106 resources. The Key Performance Indicator (KPI) is 75 per cent of the target spend which is $\pounds 4.9m$. For the first six months of the year, drawdowns by S106 funded projects totalled $\pounds 2.3m$, which is halfway towards the KPI target. A further $\pounds 2.6m$ has to be spent before the end of 2012/13 to achieve the KPI target.

This is achievable if the following projects achieve most of their target S106 drawdowns before 31 March 2013:

Only one S106 debt recovery case is left being pursued by the Council's debt litigators Judge & Priestley. This one case relates to the Black Ant Company Ltd which is under administration and owes a total £29,459 in unpaid S106 contributions for the developments at 54-56 Knatchbull Road and 29 Blenheim Gardens. Recently, the receiver for the Black Ant Company Ltd agreed to settle the outstanding debt in relation to 54-56 Knatchbull Road. In October 2012, the Council received £26,976.51 in payment for the S106 contributions owed from the development at Knatchbull Road, including the penalty interest that has accrued. Negotiations concerning 29 Blenheim Gardens are still on-going.

Newly signed S106 agreements

Of the 23 S106 agreements that were signed during the first six months of 2012/13, five involved financial contributions over £100k. These are:

- Vauxhall Cross Island site: £4,977,750 for development infrastructure in the Vauxhall Nine Elms Battersea (VNEB) area, parks and open spaces, children and young people play spaces, public transport, traffic and highway, local labour in construction, employment and training, public realm revenue and travel plan.
- Streatham Hill Depot: £650,000 specifically for sound insulation works on qualifying properties on Sternhold Avenue backing into the development site. The Council has 12 months to contractually commit the monies towards mitigating the noise from the railway affecting residents in the vicinity.
- **39 Black Prince Road:** £580,459 for education, libraries, health, community facilities, streetscape, local labour in construction, and travel plan.
- **2-16 Tinworth Street:** £376,065 for parks and open spaces, streetscape, traffic and highway, employment and training, local labour in construction, and travel plan.
- **128 Herne Hill:** £129,347 for libraries, parks and open spaces, public art, traffic and highway, local labour in construction, public realm revenue, and travel plan.

Balance at Year End

After the first six months of 2012/13, there was a balance of £14.9m in S106 funds available for the Council to spend on development mitigation measures.
