Conservation Area No. 1 Clapham — Extension
NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN in pursuance of Section
277 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1971 as
substituted by Section 1 of the Town and Country
Amenities Act 1974 that the London Borough of Lamb-
eth have determined that the area described in the
schedule to this Notice is an area of special architectural
or historic interest the character or appearance of which
it is desirable to preserve or enhance and have accord-
ingly designated the said area as a conservation area.

The effect of the designation of the conservation area
may be summarised as follows:

- Where any application for planning permission for
development of land in or adjacent to the con-
servation area is made to the council and the
development would, in the opinion of the council,
affect the character or appearance of the conserva-
tion area, the application will be subject to the
special procedure in Section 28 of the Town and
Country Planning Act 1971 as amended;
- Anyone wishing to demolish a building or a part
of a building situate within the conservation area
must first apply for consent to demolition to the
local planning authority. This is not taken to be
included in a planning permission for redevelop-
ment of the site unless, in granting the planning
permission, the authority states that it includes
consent to demolish the building, some buildings
may be exempt from this requirement;
- Anyone wishing to cut down, top, lop or uproot a
tree situate within the conservation area must give
six weeks prior Notice of his intention to the local
planning authority.

inspection between the hours of 9.30 a.m. and 4.30 p.m.
on Mondays and Fridays either at Room 213, Lambeth
Town Hall, Brixton Hill, S.W.2 or the Town Planning
Advice Centre, Directorate of Development Services,
