Designation of Conservation Area

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth in pursuance of its powers under Section 1 of the Civic Amenities Act 1967, has decided to extend an area which has already been designated as a Conservation Area within the London Borough of Lambeth as follows:—  
STOCKWELL PARK (NO. 5)

Stockwell Park Road, Stockwell  
Park Crescent and Durand Gardens,  
Add part of Stockwell Park Road,  
Lorn Road, Groveway and part of  
Brixton Road.

The object of designation is to preserve or enhance the character or appearance of areas of special architectural or historic interest as distinct from individual buildings, to control development in such areas and to stimulate and encourage measures to improve the environment.

Plans showing the extended area are available for public inspection during normal office hours either at Room 113, Lambeth Town Hall, Brixton Hill, S.W.2, or at the offices of the Director of Development Services, 138-146 Clapham Park Road, S.W.4.
