TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING GENERAL DEVELOPMENT ORDER 1973 CONSERVATION AREA No. 5 - STOCKWELL PARK

WHEREAS the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth being the Local Planning Authority for the said London Borough of Lambeth are satisfied that it is expedient that development of the description set out in Schedule 2 hereto should not be carried out on the land described in Schedule 1 hereto and should not be carried out on the plan UD/CON/128 annexed hereto unless shown edged and coloured pink on the plan UD/CON/128 annexed hereto unless shown edged and coloured pink on application made under the Town and Country permission therefor is granted on application made under the Town and Country Planning General Development Order 1973.

NOW THEREFORE the said Council in pursuance of the powers conferred upon them by Article 4 of the Town and Country Planning General Development Order 1973 hereby direct that the permission granted by Article 3 of the said Order shall not apply to development on the said land of the descriptions set out in Schedule 2 hereto.

SCHEDULE 1

Description of Land

Nos. 2-12 (even), 26-62 (even), 1-9(odd) and 17-37 (odd) Stockwell Park Crescent, S.W.9. Nos. 46-76 (even), 80-84 (even), 41-53 (odd) and 75-89 (odd) Stockwell Park Road, S.W.9.

SCHEDULE 2

Description of Development

Class 1 - Development within the curtilage of a dwelling house

- 1. The enlargement improvement or other alteration of a dwellinghouse so long as:
 - (a) The cubic content of the original dwellinghouse (as ascertained by external measurement) is not exceeded by more than 50 cubic metres or one-tenth whichever is the greater, subject to a maximum of 115 cubic metres;
 - (b) The height of the building as so enlarged altered or improved does not exceed the height of the highest part of the roof of the original dwellinghouse;
 - (c) No part of the building as so enlarged altered or improved projects beyond the forwardmost part of any wall of the original dwellinghouse which fronts on a highway.

Provided that the erection of a garage, stable, loose box or coach-house within the curtilage of the dwellinghouse shall be treated as the enlargement of the dwellinghouse for all purposes of this permission including the calculation of cubic contents.

Being development comprised within Class I (1) referred to in the First Schedule to the said Order and not being development comprised within any other class.

Class II - Sundry minor operations

1. The erection or construction of gates, fences, walls or other means of enclosure not exceeding one metre in height where abutting on a highway used by vehicular traffic or two metres in height in any other case, and the maintenance improvement or other alteration of any gates, fences, walls or other means of enclosure; so long as such improvement or alteration does not increase the height above the height appropriate for a new means of enclosure.

Being development comprised within Class II (1) referred to in the First Schedule to the said Order and not being-development comprised within any other class.
