3. STOCKWELL PARK (NO.5) CONSERVATION AREA: PROPOSED EXTENSION

This Conservation Area was designated by the Council on 10th July, 1968 (*Minutes 1968-1969, pages 64-68*) under the Civic Amenities Act 1967.

The Stockwell Park Residents' Association, supported by the Vauxhall Society, has suggested that the boundaries of the Conservation Area be extended to include the area marked on drawing No. UD/STO/103, which will be exhibited in the ante-room to the Council Chamber. Having considered this proposal with particular reference to the houses in Stockwell Park Road referred to by the Residents' Association, we have agreed that the eastern section of the Conservation Area in Stockwell Park Road could be extended where it immediately adjoins the existing conservation area boundary and to terminate at the break in the age of the housing which occurs at Nos. 21 and 16 Stockwell Park Road as indicated on the displayed map. It is considered that the houses suggested by the Residents' Association for conservation but outside the boundaries of the extended conservation area should be protected by inclusion on the Statutory List of Buildings of Architectural and Historic Interest.

We have thanked the Stockwell Park Residents' Association for its interest and have advised the Association that the Council would wish to extend the Conservation Area as indicated on drawing No. UD/STO/103 and will consult with the Greater London Council to achieve this designation. The Ministry of Housing and Local Government is also being asked to include in the Statutory List of Buildings of Architectural and Historic Interest those houses put forward for conservation by the Association but outside the extended conservation area.

A further report will be submitted in due course.
