Decision

Notice is hereby given that the London Borough of Lambeth, pursuant to a decision made on 11 December 2017 by its Cabinet, has refused the designation of the Herne Hill Forum as a Neighbourhood Planning Forum.

Reasons for decision

A neighbourhood forum is required to have a membership of at least 21 members (as set out in Section 61F(5)(c) of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990). On 11 December 2017, the Cabinet of the London Borough of Lambeth made a decision to refuse the proposed neighbourhood area as applied for and instead to designate a smaller neighbourhood area. Due to the changes made to the neighbourhood area boundary, the proposed neighbourhood forum no longer meets the requirement to have a minimum of 21 members and has been refused.
