ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14(2)

**TEMPORARY TRAFFIC AND PARKING, WAITING AND LOADING RESTRICTIONS
DERONDA ROAD**

1. The Council of the London Borough of Lambeth HEREBY GIVES NOTICE under section 14(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 that from 26th October 2018 for a period of up to 21 days, vehicles will be banned from entering, parking, waiting and loading in that length of Deronda Road which lies between the western kerb-line of Norwood Road and the eastern wall of No. 1 Deronda Road.
2. Alternative routes for affected vehicles will be available via Norwood Road, Berwyn Road and Deerbrook Road and vice versa.
3. The bans will only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs.
4. It is necessary for restrictions to come into force without delay because of likelihood of danger to the public caused by damage to the carriageway and to enable repair works are to be carried out in that road.
5. The provisions of this notice will be in force for up to 21 days during which time the Council may make a temporary order under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 to continue the restrictions until the works have been completed.
