**ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 – SECTION 14**

**TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURES – CAREW STREET AND SOUTHWELL ROAD**

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that to enable electricity connection works to be carried out, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth intends to make an Order the effect of which would be to temporarily ban vehicles from:-
  - (a) entering or proceeding in a northerly or north-easterly direction in Carew Street; and
  - (b) entering that length of Southwell Road which lies between Northlands Street and the north-eastern boundary of No. 100 Southwell Road (the north-eastern extremity of the road).
2. Alternative routes for vehicles affected by the closure of Carew Street would be available via Lilford Road, Coldharbour Lane and Denmark Road. There is no alternative route in relation to the closure of Southwell Road as that road is a no through route, however access to and egress from properties in the closed part of Southwell Road would be maintained, when the works allow it.
3. The road closures described above would only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs.
4. The Order would come into force on 30<sup>th</sup> September 2019 and it would continue for a maximum duration of 5 months or until the works have been completed, whichever is the sooner.
