ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14

**TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE - CROXTED ROAD
FOR BRIDGE INSPECTION WORKS**

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that to enable detailed bridge inspection works to be carried out to the railway bridge over Croxted Road, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth with the agreement of the Council of the London Borough of Southwark, intend to make an order the effect of which would be to temporarily ban vehicles from entering that length of Croxted Road which lies between Norwood Road and Guernsey Grove.
2. Alternative routes for vehicles would be available via (i) Norwood Road and Thurlow Park Road; and (ii) Thurlow Park Road, Norwood Road, Christchurch Road, Hardel Rise, Tulse Hill and Norwood Road.
3. The ban would only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs.
4. The order would come into force on 11th May 2019 and would continue for a maximum duration of 1 month or until the works have been completed whichever is the earlier. In practice it is anticipated that the order would only have effect between 11 pm and 6 am on 11th and 12th May and 11pm and 6 am on 18th and 19th May 2019, but if the works cannot be carried out or completed on those dates the order would also have effect on subsequent dates and times.
