**ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14**

**TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE - ESTREHAM ROAD**

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that to enable Thames Water drainage works to be carried out, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth intend to make an Order the effect of which would be to temporarily ban vehicles from entering that length of Estreham Road which lies between Eucalyptus Mews and Hambro Road.
2. The road closure would only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of traffic signs.
3. Alternative routes for affected vehicles would be available via (1) Natal Road, Streatham High Road and Greyhound Lane; and (2) Lewin Road, Streatham High Road and Natal Road and vice versa.
4. The Order would come into force on 17<sup>th</sup> February 2020 and would continue for a maximum duration of 1 month (to allow for contingencies) or until the works have been completed whichever is the sooner. In practice it is anticipated that the Order would only have effect from 10 am on 17<sup>th</sup> February until 4 pm on 18<sup>th</sup> February 2020 but if the works cannot be carried out or completed during that time then the Order would also have effect on subsequent dates.
