**ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14**

**TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE FARNHAM ROYAL**

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that, to enable works to be carried out by Thames Water, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth intend to make an order the effect of which would be to temporarily ban vehicles from entering that length of Farnham Royal which lies between its junction with Oval Way and a point 10 metres north-east of Oval Way.
2. Alternative routes would be available for affected vehicles via Oval Way and Kennington Lane and vice versa.
3. The ban would only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs.
4. The order would come into force on 16<sup>th</sup> April 2019 and would continue for a maximum duration of 1 month (to allow for contingencies) or until the works have been completed whichever is the sooner. In practice it is anticipated that the order would have effect from 16<sup>th</sup> April for 5 days but if the works cannot be carried out or completed during that time the Order may also have effect on subsequent days up to the maximum period of 1 month.
