ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14

TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE – GLENCAIRN ROAD

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that, to enable bridge repair works to be carried out to the railway bridge over Glencairn Road, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth intend to make an Order the effect of which would be to temporarily ban vehicles from entering that length of Glencairn Road which lies between Ellison Road and Sherwood Avenue.
2. Alternative routes would be available for vehicles via (i) Ellison Road, Greyhound Lane, Streatham Vale and Sherwood Avenue; and (ii) Sherwood Avenue, Streatham Vale, Greyhound Lane, Tankerville Road, Kempshott Road and Ellison Road.
3. The ban would only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs.
4. The Order would come into force on 12th September 2019 and would continue for a maximum duration of 1 month (to allow for contingencies) or until the works have been completed whichever is the earlier. In practice it is anticipated that the Order would only be in force between 10 pm on 12th September and 6 am on 13th September but if the works cannot be completed during that time the Order would also have effect on subsequent days.
