ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14

**TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE – GORDON GROVE
FOR BRIDGE INSPECTION WORKS**

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that to enable detailed bridge inspection works to be carried out to the railway bridge over Gordon Grove, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth intend to make an order the effect of which would be to temporarily ban vehicles from entering that length of Gordon Grove which lies between Flaxman Road and Wickwood Street.
2. Alternative routes for vehicles would be available via (i) Minet Road, Loughborough Road, Coldharbour Lane and Flaxman Road; and (ii) Flaxman Road, Luxor Street, Coldharbour Lane, Loughborough Road and Minet Road.
3. The ban would only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs.
4. The order would come into force on 24th May 2019 and would continue for a maximum duration of 1 month or until the works have been completed whichever is the earlier. In practice it is anticipated that the order would only have effect between 11 pm and 6 am on 24th and 25th May 2019, but if the works cannot be carried out or completed on those dates the order would also have effect on subsequent dates and times.
