TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE HEYBRIDGE AVENUE

- 1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that to enable new gas main connection works to be carried out, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth subject to the agreement of Transport for London, intend to make an order the effect of which would be to temporarily ban vehicles from entering that length of Heybridge Avenue which lies between Streatham High Road and Copley Park, whenever indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs.
- 2. Alternative routes for affected vehicles would be available via (a) Copley Park, Baldry Gardens and Braxted Park and vice versa; (b) Braxted Park, Strathbrook Road and Fontaine Road; and (c) Heybridge Avenue, Fontaine Road, Hilldown Road and Streatham High Road and vice versa.
- 3. The Order would come into force on 17th February 2020 and continue for a maximum duration of 5 months or until the works have been completed whichever is the sooner.
