**ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14(2)**

**TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE – LEIGHAM VALE**

1. The Council of the London Borough of Lambeth HEREBY GIVES NOTICE under section 14(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 that from 13<sup>th</sup> May 2019 for up to 21 days:-
  - (a) vehicles will be banned from entering that length of the north-westbound carriageway of Leigham Vale which lies between the north-western kerb-line of Knolly's Road and a point 20 metres north-west of Knolly's Road;
  - (b) a one-way system will be imposed in that length of Leigham Vale which lies between the north-western kerb-line of Knolly's Road and a point 20 metres north-west of Knolly's Road in a south-easterly direction (towards Knolly's Road).
2. An alternative route will be available for affected vehicles via Knolly's Road, Leigham Court Road, Rosedene Avenue and Stockfield Road.
3. It is necessary for the road closure to come into force without delay to enable urgent water main repair works to be carried out.
4. The road closure will be in force by virtue of this notice for up to 21 days or until the repair works have been completed, whichever is the sooner. If the works cannot be completed during that period, the Council may issue a further notice under section 14(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 or make a temporary order under section 14(1) of that Act, so as to continue in force the provisions of this Notice until the repair works have been completed.
