ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 16A

**TEMPORARY RESTRICTION OF PEDESTRIAN AND VEHICULAR TRAFFIC GRANBY PLACE,
GRINDAL STREET, LEAKE STREET AND LOWER MARSH AND TEMPORARY PARKING
RESTRICTIONS IN LOWER MARSH FOR FILMING**

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that to enable filming to take place in Lower Marsh, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth intend to make an Order the effect of which would be to temporarily ban:-
 - (a) pedestrians from entering (i) Granby Place; (ii) Grindal Street; (iii) Leake Street, between Lower Marsh and Station Approach; and (iv) Lower Marsh (In practice it is anticipated that filming would be intermittent, so pedestrian access to and from premises in the above roads would be maintained outside filming);
 - (b) vehicles from entering or waiting (including waiting for the purpose of loading or unloading a vehicle) in that length of Lower Marsh which lies between Westminster Bridge Road and its junction with Launcelot Street and Frazier Street,on Sunday 8th December 2019.
- 2 The bans would only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs.
- 3 Whenever the bans referred to in paragraph 1(b) above apply the one-way system in that length of Lower Marsh which lies between Westminster Bridge Road and Frazier Street would be suspended.
- 4 An alternative route would be available for affected vehicles via Westminster Bridge Road and Baylis Road.
- 5 An alternative route would be available for affected pedestrians via Westminster Bridge Road and Frazier Street.
