**ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14**

**TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE – MEPHAM STREET**

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that to enable bridge inspection, maintenance and repair works to be carried out to the railway bridge over Mepham Street, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth intend to make an Order the effect of which would be to temporarily ban vehicles from entering Mepham Street.
2. An alternative route for vehicles affected by the closure would be available via York Road, Addington Street, Westminster Bridge Road, Baylis Road and Waterloo Road.
3. The road closure would only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs.
4. The Order would come into force on 22<sup>nd</sup> February 2020 and it would continue for a maximum duration of 12 months or until the works have been completed whichever is the sooner. In practice it is anticipated that the Order would be in force between 22<sup>nd</sup> and 24<sup>th</sup> February (inclusive), 1<sup>st</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> May (inclusive), 9<sup>th</sup> and 11<sup>th</sup> May (inclusive), 6<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> June (inclusive), 26<sup>th</sup> and 28<sup>th</sup> September (inclusive) and 28<sup>th</sup> and 30<sup>th</sup> November 2020 (inclusive), between 11 pm and 5 am on each occasion. If the works cannot be carried out or completed on those dates or during that time, the Order would also have effect on subsequent dates and times.
