ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14

**TEMPORARY TRAFFIC RESTRICTIONS LANCASTER AVENUE, NORWOOD ROAD
AND YORK HILL AND TEMPORARY PARKING RESTRICTIONS
LANCASTER AVENUE AND YORK HILL**

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that to enable Thames Water to carry out trunk mains replacement works in Norwood Road, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth intend to make an Order the effect of which would be to temporarily:-

(a) ban vehicles from entering or waiting in that length of:-

(i) York Hill, which lies between Norwood Road and a point 33.5 metres south-west of Norwood Road;

(ii) Lancaster Avenue, which lies between Norwood Road and Dalton Street;

(b) ban vehicles proceeding in Norwood Road from:-

(i) turning left into (a) Lancaster Avenue; and (b) York Hill;

(ii) turning right into (a) Lancaster Avenue; and (b) York Hill.

2. The bans would only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs.

3. Alternative routes would be available for vehicles affected by the bans described in paragraph 1 above, via adjacent roads as indicated by traffic signs.

4. The Order would come into force on 23rd April 2019 and continue for a maximum duration of 6 months or until the works have been completed whichever is the sooner.
