ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14

TEMPORARY TRAFFIC AND PARKING RESTRICTIONS ST GOTHARD ROAD

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that, to enable water main repair works to be carried out, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth, intend to make an order the effect of which would be to temporarily ban vehicles from entering or waiting (including waiting for the purpose of loading and unloading a vehicle) in that length of St Gothard Road which lies between Beeton Way and the party wall of Nos. 80 and 82 St Gothard Road.
2. Alternative routes for affected vehicles would be available via Carnac Street, Clive Road, Hamilton Road, Gipsy Road, Rommany Road and St Louis Road and vice versa.
3. The bans would only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs.
4. The order would come into force on 30th April 2019 and would continue for a maximum duration of 2 months or until the works have been completed whichever is the earlier. In practice it is anticipated that the Order would only have effect from 30th April for 4 days but if the works cannot be completed or carried out on those dates, the order would also have effect on subsequent dates within the maximum duration of 2 months.
