### ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14

#### TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE - UFFORD STREET AND WEBBER STREET

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that, to enable water main repair works to be carried out, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth, intend to make an order the effect of which would be to temporarily ban vehicles from entering that length of:-

- (a) **Ufford Street** which lies between Webber Street and the party wall of Nos. 2 and 3 Ufford Street (alternative routes would be available for affected vehicles via **(i)** Webber Street, Blackfriars Road, The Cut and Short Street; and **(ii)** Short Street and Mitre Road and vice versa);
- (b) **Webber Street** which lies between the party wall of Nos. 5a to 5d and Nos. 7a to 7f Webber Street and the south-eastern boundary of No. 1 Ufford Street (approximately 26 metres south-east of Ufford Street) (alternative routes would be available for affected vehicles via **(i)** Gray Street, Waterloo Road, Sandell Street, Cornwall Road, The Cut, Short Street and Mitre Road; and **(ii)** Mitre Road, Short Street, The Cut, Waterloo Road and Gray Street).

2. The bans would only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs.

3. The order would come into force on 5<sup>th</sup> May 2019 and would continue for a maximum duration of 1 month or until the works have been completed whichever is the earlier. In practice it is anticipated that the Order would only have effect from 5<sup>th</sup> May for 5 days, but if the works cannot be completed or carried out on those dates the order would also have effect on subsequent dates within the maximum duration.
