

LONDON BOROUGH OF LAMBETH
ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 – SECTION 14
TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE – WESTOW HILL

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that to enable repair works to be carried out by Thames Water, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth intends to make an Order the effect of which would be to temporarily:-
 - (a) ban vehicles from entering that length of Westow Hill which lies between the western kerb-line of Cooper's Yard and the western kerb-line of Beardell Street; and
 - (b) suspend the banned left turn from Central Hill into Gypsy Hill to facilitate the alternative routes specified in paragraph 2 below.
2. Alternative routes for affected vehicles would be available via (a) Gypsy Hill, Gypsy Road, Dulwich Wood Park, College Road and Crystal Palace Parade; and (b) Gypsy Hill, Camden Hill Road and Woodland Road.
3. The road closure and suspension of the banned left turn described above would only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing, or covering, of the appropriate traffic signs.
4. The Order would come into force on 4th October 2019 and it would continue for a maximum duration of 3 months (to allow for contingencies) or until the works have been completed, whichever is the sooner. In practice it is anticipated that the Order would only have effect from 12.05 am until 6.00 am on 4th, 5th and 6th October 2019, but if the works cannot be carried out or completed during those times, then the Order may have effect at other times within the maximum duration of 3 months.
