**ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14**

**TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE – BAYTREE ROAD**

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that, to enable sewer repair works to be carried out, the Council of London Borough of Lambeth, subject to the agreement of Transport for London intend to make an order the effect of which would be to temporarily ban vehicles from entering that length of Baytree Road which lies between Brixton Hill and a point 20 metres north-west of Brixton Hill.
2. The road closure would only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs.
3. Alternative routes would be available for all vehicles affected by the closure via (a) Acre Lane and Brixton Road; and (b) Acre Lane, Brixton Road, Effra Road, St Matthews Road and Brixton Hill.
4. An alternative route for cyclists would be available via Brixton Hill and Acre Lane.
5. The order would come into force on 4<sup>th</sup> March 2019 and it would continue for a maximum duration of 2 months or until the works have been completed whichever is the earlier. In practice it is anticipated that the order would have effect from 4<sup>th</sup> March 2019 for 6 weeks but if the works cannot be completed or carried out during that time the order would also have effect on subsequent dates within the maximum period of 2 months.
