ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 – SECTION 14

TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE – BELVEDERE ROAD

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that to enable public realm works to be carried out in connection with the Shell Centre redevelopment, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth intend to make an Order the effect of which would be to temporarily:
 - (a) ban vehicles from entering in a southerly direction that length of Belvedere Road which lies between the southern kerb-line of Concert Hall Approach and northern kerb-line of Chicheley Street; and
 - (b) ban vehicles proceeding in a northerly direction in the length of Belvedere Road referred to in paragraph 1(a) above from turning left or right into any land or property adjacent to that length of Belvedere Road.
2. Alternative routes for vehicles affected by the road closure referred to in paragraph 1(a) above would be available via Concert Hall Approach, the roundabout at the junction of Waterloo Road, York Road and Stamford Street (known as the Waterloo or Imax Roundabout), York Road and Chicheley Street.
3. The road closure and banned turns would only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs.
4. The Order would come into force on 7th January 2019 and continue for a maximum duration of 8 months (to allow for contingencies) or until the works have been completed whichever is the sooner. It is anticipated that the Order would only have effect for about 6 months but if the works cannot be completed during that time, then the Order may continue for the maximum period of 8 months.
