**ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14**

**TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE – CANTERBURY GROVE**

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that to enable water main repair works to be carried out, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth have made an Order the effect of which will be to temporarily ban vehicles from entering that length of Canterbury Grove which lies between No. 111 Canterbury Grove and No. 117 Canterbury Grove.
2. The above road closure will only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs.
3. Alternative routes for affected vehicles will be available via Ivymont Road, Egremont Road and Chartham Grove and vice versa.
4. The Order will come into force on 13<sup>th</sup> September 2018 and will continue in force for a maximum duration of 1 month (to allow for contingences) or until the works have been completed whichever is the sooner. In practice it is anticipated that the works will be carried out between 13<sup>th</sup> and 15<sup>th</sup> September 2018 but if the works cannot be carried out or completed in that time then the Order may have effect on subsequent days up to the maximum period of 1 month.
