**ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14**

**TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE – CARLISLE LANE**

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that to enable works to inspect a railway bridge to be carried out, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth intend to make an Order the effect of which would be to temporarily: -
  - (a) ban vehicles from entering the east to west arm of Carlisle Lane (which lies between its junction with Hercules Road and its junction with the south to north arm of Carlisle Lane); and
  - (b) suspend the existing one-way traffic system in Carlisle Lane to allow access and egress for vehicles affected by the above road closure.
2. An alternative route would be available for affected vehicles via Hercules Road and Virgil Street.
3. The road closure and suspension of the one-way traffic system would only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing or covering of the appropriate traffic signs.
4. The Order would come into force on 6<sup>th</sup> November 2018 and it would continue for a maximum duration of 1 month (to allow for contingencies) or until the works have been completed whichever is the sooner. In practice it is anticipated that the Order would only have effect from 10 pm on 6<sup>th</sup> November 2018 until 6 am on 7<sup>th</sup> November 2018 but if the works cannot be carried out or completed during that time, then the Order may have effect at other times within the maximum period of 1 month.
