WAITING RESTRICTIONS IN CAVENDISH ROAD - ADMINISTRATIVE CHANGES

[NOTE: This Notice is about carrying out administrative changes so that the traffic order that imposes waiting restrictions on vehicles in Cavendish Road (these restrictions are indicated by yellow lines on the carriageway) are in line with the restrictions that currently apply on the ground.]

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth on 20th March 2019 made the Lambeth (Waiting and Loading Restriction) (Amendment No. 282) Order 2019, under sections 6 and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984. The Order will come into force on 25th March 2019.
2. The general effect of the Order will be to make certain administrative changes to the existing traffic order that imposes waiting restrictions on vehicles in Cavendish Road, so as to ensure that order better reflects the waiting restrictions that currently apply on the ground. No changes will be made to the existing on-street restrictions.
3. The Order is necessary for administrative purposes.

A copy of the Order and documents giving more details about it are available for inspection from 9.30 am until 4.30 pm on Mondays to Fridays inclusive (except bank/public holidays) until the last day of a period of six weeks beginning with the date on which the Order is made, at the offices of Lambeth Council's Highways and Enforcement Group (Environment and Growth), 3rd Floor, Civic Centre, 6 Brixton Hill, London SW2 1EG. 6. If any person wishes to question the validity of the Order or of any of its provisions on the grounds that it or they are not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or that any requirement of that Act or of any instrument made under that Act has not been complied with, that person may, within 6 weeks from the date on which the Order is made, apply for the purpose to the High Court.
