STOPPING UP OF FOOTWAY - COLDHARBOUR LANE, LONDON SW9

(Note: This notice is about stopping up a part of the footway of Coldharbour Lane so that it ceases to be public highway and becomes part of the redeveloped land at the junction of Coldharbour Lane and Somerleyton Road.)

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth on 13th March 2019 made an Order under section 247 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 ("the Act"), entitled the London Borough of Lambeth (Stopping-Up of Highways) (Coldharbour Lane) Order 2019.
2. The Order will authorise the stopping-up of an area of the footway on the south-east side of Coldharbour Lane (at its junction with Somerleyton Road).
3. The stopping-up of highway is authorised only to enable the development described in the Schedule to this Notice to be carried out, in accordance with the planning permission granted under Part III of the Act to the London Borough of Lambeth on 23rd March 2017 under reference 15/05282/RG3.
4. Any person aggrieved by the Order and desiring to question the validity thereof, or of any provision contained therein, on the grounds that it is not within the powers of the above Act or that any requirement of that Act or any regulation made thereunder has not been complied with in relation to that Order, may apply to the High Court for the suspension or quashing of the Order or of any provisions contained therein by 26th April 2019.

SCHEDULE

DEVELOPMENT AT: Land bounded by Coldharbour Lane, Somerleyton Road and Railway Line, London, SW9. Demolition of the existing buildings on site (with the exception of Carlton Mansions, which will be retained and refurbished) and redevelopment to provide a residential-led, mixed use development comprising 304 new dwellings and approximately 8,000 sq.m (GIA) of non-residential uses including a theatre (Sui Generis) and employment, retail and community uses (use class B1/D1/A1/A2) with associated parking, landscaping and ancillary works.
