ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14

**TEMPORARY “AT ANY TIME” PARKING, WAITING AND LOADING
RESTRICTIONS IN EDGINGTON ROAD**

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that to enable the safe flow of traffic into, out of and past a Network Rail works site in Edgington Road, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth intend to make an Order the effect of which would be to temporarily ban parking and waiting by vehicles (including waiting for the purpose of loading or unloading the vehicle) at any time in that length of Edgington Road which lies on the south-east side of the north-western arm of Edgington Road, between the south-western kerb-line of Eardley Road and the north-eastern kerb-line of the south-western arm of Edgington Road.
2. The ban on parking and waiting by vehicles would only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs.
3. The Order would come into force on 20th January 2018 and it would continue for a maximum duration of 12 months (to allow for contingencies) or until the works have been completed, whichever is the sooner.
