ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14

TEMPORARY PARKING, WAITING AND LOADING RESTRICTIONS IN CONNECTION WITH THE FRIENDSFEST – KENNINGTON PARK

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth, with the agreement of the London Borough of Southwark, have made an Order, the effect of which will be to temporarily ban vehicles from waiting (including waiting for the purpose of loading or unloading a vehicle) in that length of:-

- (i) Kennington Park Gardens, which lies on the south-west side, between St Agnes Place and a point 9 metres south-east of St Agnes Place;
- (ii) Meadcroft Road, both sides, between St Agnes Place and the north-western boundary of the Vicarage, No. 37 St Agnes Place; and
- (iii) St Agnes Place, both sides between Kennington Park Gardens and a point 9 metres north-east of No. 6 St Agnes Place.

2. The bans will only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of temporary traffic signs and 'no parking cones'. They are necessary because of the likelihood of danger to the public caused by an increase in pedestrian and vehicular traffic and parking in the vicinity while the Friendsfest events are taking place in Kennington Park.

3. The Order will come into force on 16th September 2018 and will continue in force for a maximum duration of 1 month. In practice it is anticipated that the Order will only have effect at certain times between 16th and 21st September 2018 and between 30th September and 3rd October 2018 but if it is deemed necessary in the interest of public safety the Order may also have effect at other times during that maximum period of 1 month.
