ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14

**TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURES – GLENELDON ROAD, GRACEFIELD GARDENS, LEIGHAM VALE,
TULSE HILL AND VALLEY ROAD**

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that, to enable carriageway works to be carried out safely the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth with the agreement of Transport for London, have made an Order the effect of which will be to temporarily ban vehicles from entering or waiting in:-

- (a) that length of **Gleneldon Road** which lies between Madeira Road and Stanthorpe Road (alternative routes will be available for affected vehicles via **(i)** Stanthorpe Road, Streatham High Road, Hopton Road and Madiera Road; and **(ii)** Madeira Road, Oakdale Road, Valley Road, Sunnyhill Road and Streatham High Road);
- (b) **Gracefield Gardens**, the whole length (alternative routes will be available for affected vehicles via **(i)** Streatham High Road, Pendennis Road and Leithcote Gardens and vice versa; and **(ii)** Leithcote Garden, Ivyday Grove, Culverhouse Gardens, Leigham Court Road and Streatham High Road);
- (c) **Leigham Vale**, the whole length (alternative routes will be available for affected vehicles via **(i)** Norwood Road, Christchurch Road, Streatham Hill, Leigham Court Road and Knolly's Road; and **(ii)** Norwood Road, Norwood High Street, Ernest Avenue, Knight's Hill, Crown Lane, Leigham Court Road and Knolly's Road;
- (d) that length of **Tulse Hill** which lies between Caignair Road and Hillworth Road (alternative routes will be available via **(i)** Brixton Water Lane, Brixton Hill, Christchurch Road and Hardel Rise; and **(ii)** Norwood Road, Christchurch Road, Brixton Hill and Brixton Water Lane);
- (e) **Valley Road**, between Leigham Court Road and Wellfield Road (alternative routes will be available for affected vehicles via **(i)** Valleyfield Road and Leigham Court Road and vice versa; and **(ii)** Leigham Court Road, Streatham High Road, Sunnyhill Road and Wellfield Road).

2. The above road closures will only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs.

3. The Order will come into force on 16th July 2018 and it will continue for a maximum duration of 12 months or until the works have been completed whichever is the sooner. The works will be conducted on a "rolling" programme and, as such, not all the restrictions stated in paragraph 1 will be in force in all the affected roads at any one time.
