ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14

**TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF KINFAUNS ROAD AND DAYSBROOK ROAD AND TEMPORARY
“AT ANY TIME” PARKING, WAITING AND LOADING RESTRICTIONS IN DAYSBROOK ROAD
ROAD, HILLSIDE ROAD, KINFAUNS ROAD, KINGSMEAD ROAD,
LEIGHAM VALE AND PALACE ROAD**

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that to enable Thames Water to carry out works to water mains, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth intend to make Orders the effect of which would be to temporarily:-

- (a) ban vehicles from entering Kinfauns Road, except for vehicles gaining access to properties in Kinfauns Road via Kingsmead Road (alternative routes are available via Palace Road and Kingsmead Road and vice versa);
- (b) ban vehicles from entering in a southerly direction that length of Daysbrook Road which lies between Palace Road and Wavertree Road (an alternative route is available via Palace Road, Roupell Road, Christchurch Road, Streatham Hill and Wavertree Road);
- (c) ban parking and waiting by vehicles (including waiting for the purpose of loading or unloading the vehicle) at any time in the lengths of roads specified in the Schedule to this Notice.

2 The road closures and ban on parking and waiting described above would only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs. It is not anticipated that they would all apply at the same time, but that they would apply in stages as the works progress.

3. The Order would come into force on 29th May 2018 and it would continue for a maximum duration of 7 months or until the works have been completed whichever is the sooner.

SCHEDULE

Daysbrook Road, both sides, from its junction with Palace Road to the common boundary of Nos. 1 and 1c Daysbrook Road.

Hillside Road, both sides, from the common boundary of Nos. 6 and 6a Hillside Road to the common boundary of No. 51 Palace Road and No. 4 Hillside Road.

Kinfauns Road, both sides, from its junction with Palace Road to its junction with Leigham Vale.

Kingsmead Road, both sides, from the western kerb-line of Kinfauns Road to the common boundary of Nos. 3 and 5 Kingsmead Road.

Leigham Vale, both sides, from the common boundary of Nos. 103 and 104 Leigham Vale to the (rear) common boundary of Nos. 3 and 5 Kingsmead Road.

Palace Road, both sides, (a) from the common boundary of Nos. 100 and 102 Palace Road to the common boundary of Nos. 84 and 86 Palace Road; (b) from the common boundary of Nos. 55 and 57 Palace Road to the common boundary of Nos. 54a and 54b Palace Road; and (c) from the western kerb-line of Roupell Road to its junction with Christchurch Road.
