### **ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14**

#### **TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE – BINFIELD ROAD**

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that to enable works to gas mains to be carried out, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth intend to make an Order the effect of which would be to temporarily ban all vehicles from entering that length of Binfield Road which lies between its junction with Clapham Road and South Lambeth Road and the south-eastern kerb-line of Studley Road, including the cycle lane in that length of road.
2. The above road closure would only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs.
3. An alternative route for north-westbound vehicles affected by the road closure would be available via South Lambeth Road, Lansdowne Way and Binfield Road. An alternative route for the south-eastbound pedal cycles affected by the closure of the cycle lane would be available via Binfield Road, Lansdowne Way, South Lambeth Road and Clapham Road.
4. The Order would come into force on 15<sup>th</sup> October 2018 and it would continue for a maximum duration of 3 months (to allow for contingencies) or until the works have been completed whichever is the sooner. In practice it is anticipated that the Order would only have effect for approximately 2 weeks but if the works cannot be carried out or completed during that time then the Order may have effect at additional times within the maximum period of 3 months.
