

LONDON BOROUGH OF LAMBETH

PROPOSED REMOVAL OF EXISTING PARKING SPACES TO ACCOMMODATE NEW BICYCLE PARKING HANGARS IN VARIOUS ROADS

(Note: This notice is about proposals to remove 2.6 metres of parking space at each of the locations specified in paragraph 2 below, so as to provide space for the installation of secure bicycle parking hangars instead. Objections or other comments may be made – see paragraph 6.)

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth proposes to make the Lambeth (Brixton “B”) (Parking Places) (No. -) Order 201-, the Lambeth (Brixton “E”) (Parking Places) (No. -) Order 201-, the Lambeth (Brixton Hill East) (Parking Places) (No. -) Order 201-, the Lambeth (Brixton Hill “D”) (Parking Places) (No. -) Order 201-, the Lambeth (Camberwell) (Parking Places) (No. -) Order 201-, the Lambeth (Clapham “C”) (Parking Places) (No. -) Order 201-, the Lambeth (Kennington) (Parking Places) (No. -) Order 201-, the Lambeth (Stockwell) (Parking Places) (No. -) Order 201-, the Lambeth (Tulse Hill) (Parking Places) (No. -) Order 201- and the Lambeth (Vassall “V”) (Parking Places) (No. -) Order 201-, under sections 45, 46, 49 and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

2. The general effect of the Orders would be to remove 2.6 metres of parking space at each of the following locations (the type of parking space that would be removed is residents permit holder parking space unless otherwise indicated in brackets):-

- (a) **Clayton Street** (i) on the north-west side outside Read House; and (ii) on the north-west side, outside Sherwin House (shared-use residents/business/pay & display or pay by phone parking space);
- (b) **Cormont Road**, on the west side, outside Dover House;
- (c) **Eastlake Road**, on the south-west side, outside No. 32;
- (d) **Edithna Street**, on the east side, outside the entrance to Nos. 18 and 20;
- (e) **Elmcourt Road**, on the south-east side, outside Nos. 50 to 64 Orford Court (shared-use residents/business/pay & display or pay by phone parking space);
- (f) **Ferndale Road**, on the south side, outside Nos. 3 and 5;
- (g) **Goldsboro’ Road**, on the east side, at the side of No. 9 Crimsworth Road;
- (h) **Helix Road**, on the west side, outside No. 24;
- (i) **Kingswood Road** (i) on the east side, outside No. 21; and (ii) on the east side, opposite No. 112 (shared-use residents/business/pay & display or pay by phone parking space);
- (j) **Lilford Road**, on the south side, adjacent to No. 26;
- (k) **Robertson Street**, on the south-east side, outside No. 130 (shared-use residents/business parking space);
- (l) **Rosebery Road**, on the north side, outside No. 29;
- (m) **Solon Road**, on the west side, outside No. 33; and
- (n) **Sulina Road**, on the north-west side, at the side of No. 42/42A Morrish Road. (shared-use residents/business/pay & display or pay by phone parking space).

3. The proposed Orders are necessary to make spaces for the provision of secure bicycle parking hangars for residents who do not have the space and/or ability to securely park bicycles in or within a reasonable distance from their home with the aim of reducing theft, improving the street scene and encouraging people to choose cycling as a safe and secure mode of transport.
