ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14

TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURES – UFFORD STREET AND WEBBER STREET

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that to enable water main repair works to be carried out, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth intend to make an Order the effect of which would be to temporarily ban vehicles from entering the length of:-
 - (a) Ufford Street, which lies between its junction with Webber Street and the common boundary of Nos. 2 and 3 Ufford Street; and
 - (b) Webber Street, which lies between the common boundary of Nos. 5 and 7 Webber Street and the south-eastern boundary of No. 1 Ufford Street.
2. The above road closures would only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs.
3. Alternative routes would be available for affected vehicles via (a) Short Street and Mitre Road; (b) Gray Street, Waterloo Road, Sandell Street, Cornwall Road, The Cut, Short Street and Mitre Road; and (c) Mitre Road, Short Street, The Cut, Waterloo Road and Gray Street.
4. The Order would come into force on 16th October 2018 and continue for a maximum duration of 1 month (to allow for contingencies) or until the works have been completed whichever is the sooner. In practice it is anticipated that the Order would only have effect for approximately 5 days but if the works cannot be carried out or completed during that time then the Order may have effect on additional days within the maximum period of 1 month.
