ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14

TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE – LEAKE STREET

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth, following the recommendation of the Metropolitan Police, have made an Order under sections 14(1)(b) and 22(c) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by the Civil Contingencies Act 2004, for the purpose of avoiding or reducing the likelihood of danger or damage connected with terrorism.
2. The effect of the Order will be to allow the police, at their discretion, to temporarily ban vehicles from entering that length of Leake Street which lies between a point 45 metres south-east of the south-eastern kerb-line of York Road and the south-eastern extremity of the public highway.
3. An alternative route is not applicable because Leake Street is a no through road.
4. The Order will also permit a police constable to direct that any provision of the Order be suspended, commenced or revived and as well as conferring discretion on the police constable, also confers power on a constable as to the placing of structures or traffic signs as appropriate.
5. The Order will come into force on 9th August 2017 and it will continue for a maximum duration of 18 months or until such time as the Council is advised by the Metropolitan Police that the Order is no longer required, whichever is the sooner.
