### ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14

#### TEMPORARY PARKING PLACE SUSPENSIONS AND A BAN ON PARKING AND WAITING IN MILES STREET, TRENCHOLD STREET AND WYVIL ROAD

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that to enable re-development works to be carried out safely, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth have made an Order the effect of which will be:-
  - (a) in Miles Street to suspend and temporarily remove the shared use residents', business and pay and display parking place situated on the south-west of that road adjacent to St Anne's Church and replace it with double yellow lines (this will have the effect of banning waiting at any time);
  - (b) in Trenchold Street to suspend and temporarily remove the residents' parking places situated on the east side of that road and ban waiting in that length of road between 8 am and 6 pm Monday to Saturday inclusive instead (single yellow line);
  - (c) in Wyvil Road to suspend and temporarily remove:-
    - (i) 12 metres of the shared use residents' and business and Pay and Display parking place situated on the north side of Wyvil Road outside No. 8 Wyvil Road and replace it with double yellow lines (this will have the effect of banning waiting at any time);
    - (ii) 23 metres of shared use residents' and business and pay and display parking place situated on the north-west side of Wyvil Road outside No. 10 Wyvil Road and replace it with double yellow lines (this will have the effect of banning waiting at any time);
    - (iii) 6 metres of residents' parking place situated on the south-east side of Wyvil Road opposite Nos. 10 and 12-20 Wyvil Road and replace it with double yellow lines (this will have the effect of banning waiting at any time);
    - (iv) 11 metres of the shared use residents' and business and pay and display parking place situated on the north side of Wyvil Road outside No. 8 and ban waiting in that length of road between 8 am and 6 pm Monday to Saturday inclusive instead (single yellow line);
  - (d) to ban waiting at any time (double yellow lines) in the lengths of road specified in Schedule to this Notice.
2. The suspensions and waiting restrictions will only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs.
3. The Order will come into force on 30<sup>th</sup> April 2018 and it will continue for a maximum duration of 18 months or until the works have been completed whichever is the sooner.

#### SCHEDULE

- (a) **Trenchold Street**, the west side.
- (b) **Wyvil Road**,
  - (i) the north and north-west side
    - (1) between Trenchold Street and a point 29 metres south-west of Trenchold Street;
    - (2) between a point 14.5 metres east of Trenchold Street and a point 41 metres east of Trenchold Street;
  - (ii) the south-east side, between a point 25.1 metres south-west of Trenchold Street and a point 31.1 metres south-west of Trenchold Street.
